CHORD	Girl Child Project	52	Telangana	The initiative supported 52 children from communities like child laborers, school dropouts, and vulnerable children aged 7-14 in Serilingampalli, Hyderabad with a focus on primary to higher education. Girls were enrolled in schools, helping bridge the education gap. The program enabled students and their families to lead dignified and independent lives.
	DAYA Remedial School for Urban Deprived Children	95	Telangana	Daya Remedial School worked towards educating, empowering, and enriching the lives of children by providing primary to higher education and vocational training in Hyderabad. 5 slum clusters were covered, reaching 120 households and enrolling 95 children in Classes 1 to 5 based on their learning abilities.
	STEM Education for Urban Deprived	200	Telangana	CHORD-Ashirwad English Medium School in Bachupally, Hyderabad fostered creative thinking, problem-solving, and critical thinking skills for 200 students, that focused on urban deprived children and children rescued from labor force. A comprehensive needs assessment was done for the establishment of a Mini Science Centre and a Tinkering STEM Lab to strengthen foundational concepts and spark interest in STEM. This initiative aimed to boost students' confidence in these subjects and promote STEM based careers in children from underserved communities.
Collective Good Foundation	STEM and Robotic Labs in Telangana	4970	Telangana	6 Government Schools in Hyderabad, Telangana were set up with STEM and Robotics Labs, equipped with DIY kits, science and math models, and robotics kits. This initiative offered a blended learning approach, combining hands-on lab activities with online learning to empower students for real-world success.

Nirmaan Organization	Project Sankalp- PwD Skilling and Employment Program	202	Karnataka	The project was set up in Bangalore. It focused on establishing a digital skilling institute to train Persons with Disabilities in IT, ITES, and retail jobs, along with career counseling and job placements. 202 candidates were trained, and 51% beneficiaries received employment under this project.
Quest Alliance	EcosySTEM	2632	Telangana	The Hyderabad based program cultivated STEM mindsets, enhanced technology proficiency, promoted gender sensitization, inspired students to complete secondary education and plan for higher education and careers. EcosySTEM project impacted 2,632 students from 2 Hyderabad government schools (6th-8th grade). Its curriculum included classroom interventions, hackathons, and visits to T-Hub for exposure.
Rubaroo	Youth Lab: Nurturing Leaders and Innovators	485	Telangana	23 young women were trained as career mentors who guided 462 adolescent girls from under-resourced communities in co-creating career paths for workforce entry, with a focus on digital literacy and technology. This Hyderabad initiative aimed to promote women's participation in STEM fields, build leadership in youth mentors, and inspire adolescents through workshops to build personal agency to pursue their aspirations, did parental counseling, and mapped career paths for adolescents.
United Way Bengaluru	Integrated School Development Programme - STEM Education	3854	Karnataka	The project established STEM Labs with 70 experiments and equipment in 8 government schools in Hoskote, providing training to teachers from these schools and 9 previously supported ones. This initiative, benefiting 2,736 students this year, also included a comprehensive needs assessment, capacity building for STEM teaching, and science exhibitions where AMD volunteers participated as judges.
	Smart Tv Classrooms for Entrance exam Coaching in PU Colleges in Karnataka	6670	Karnataka	21 Pre-University (PU) colleges have been equipped with Smart TV Classrooms for IIT Joint Entrance Examination (JEE). This initiative aims to enhance the capacity of government PU colleges in Davangere District, Karnataka, making students more competitive and ready for the future.

United Way of Delhi	Special Workforce Development in ESDM sector	200	NCR	UWD, provided 300 hours of industry-relevant training and apprenticeships in the ESDM sector to 202 youth from socio-economically disadvantaged communities in Delhi. The project also provided the beneficiaries with placement opportunities.
Society for Innovation and Entrepreneurship (SINE)	Project Support Towards Research to Start-ups, Research Grants for Startups	1	Maharashtra	The project supported the research of the start-up , Numelo Technologies Pvt limited, incubated in SINE, an incubator in IIT, Bombay. The start will be developing ultra-low power spiking neural network (SNN) chips to enable intelligent sensors.
