Environmental, Health and Safety (EHS) Policy Statement

AMD designs innovative, customer-centric semiconductor solutions that aim to uphold the highest standard of responsible environmental, health and safety (EHS) business practices. We strive to bring integrity and accountability to each business decision as it relates to environmental impacts and the health and safety of AMD employees, contractors, suppliers, and stakeholders.

We pursue world-class EHS performance everywhere we operate, with global performance based EHS Standards and the ISO 14001 and ISO 45001 certifications of select sites. Our fundamental commitment to comply with EHS laws and regulations includes third party EHS regulatory compliance audits and internal EHS assessments. We also undergo annual external assurance and publicly report on key environmental indicators.

We are dedicated to providing and maintaining a safe workplace, healthy working conditions and protecting the environment. Our processes and objectives include voluntarily conserving energy, water, and materials; minimizing environmental impacts from waste including electronic and any chemical waste, greenhouse gases and other emissions; reducing occupational health and safety hazards and risks; and preventing and mitigating injuries and illnesses. Through employee volunteerism, sustainable commuting, and financial donations, we contribute to the local communities where we operate. We also work with the supplier facilities that manufacture AMD products to monitor EHS performance, including annually assessing adherence to the Responsible Business Alliance (RBA) Code of Conduct, maintaining EHS ISO certifications, and pursuing environmental, health and safety goals. Across our value chain, we set public goals in critical performance areas. These goals embrace science-based climate principles for our operations, energy efficiency for our products, and resource efficiency for our manufacturing suppliers.

Our culture of EHS excellence is built through senior management and stakeholder involvement, staff and supplier training, manufacturing facility assessments and third-party audits, product energy efficiency design and assessment, and transparent reporting on performance. We are committed to the continual improvement of EHS performance. Regular management reviews are held to evaluate progress, along with semi-annual briefings to senior management. The AMD Board of Directors also receives corporate responsibility updates at least annually.
