

# AMD AI DevDay 2026 — FAQ

## General Questions

### What is AMD AI DevDay?

AMD AI DevDay is a free, in-person event designed for developers working in artificial intelligence and machine learning. The day features keynote presentations, technical sessions, hands-on workshops, and opportunities to engage directly with AMD engineers and industry experts.

### When and where is the event?

AMD AI DevDay will take place on Thursday, April 30, 2026, at Convene, located at 40 O'Farrell Street, San Francisco, CA. Doors open at 9:00 AM PT, and programming will run through 6:30 PM PT.

### How much does it cost to attend?

Attendance is free; however, advance [registration](#) is required.

### Will there be a virtual or livestream option?

No. This is an in-person-only event.

### Who should attend?

This event is intended for AI and ML engineers, software developers, data scientists, researchers, and individuals interested in building or experimenting with GPU-accelerated AI using AMD hardware. Sessions are designed to accommodate a range of experience levels.

### What is the event format?

The program includes keynote presentations, technical and featured talks, eight hands-on workshop sessions, and ample networking opportunities with AMD engineers and fellow developers.

### Do I need to bring a laptop?

A laptop is not required for main-stage technical sessions. However, attendees registered for the following workshops must bring a laptop:

- *Building Your Personal OpenClaw Agent with Open-Source Models*
- *Build a Synthetic Data Generation Pipeline in a Digital Twin World*

### Are walk-ins welcome?

Walk-in attendance is permitted if space allows. However, advanced registration is strongly recommended, particularly for workshops, which are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

### Will food be provided?

Yes. Breakfast, lunch, snacks, coffee, and light refreshments during the networking hours will be provided.

### Is there a minimum age requirement?

Yes, all attendees must be 18 years of age or older.

There are five unique, instructor-led workshops focused on building practical solutions using AMD hardware. The following workshops are offered multiple times:

- *On-Device Model Finetuning: Unsloth × Ryzen AI Strix Halo*

### How do I select a workshop?

Workshop selection is completed during registration. Capacity is limited, so early registration is encouraged. If a workshop is full, you may join a waitlist or attend on a space-available basis on the day of the event.

### Can I change my workshop selection?

Yes, changes can be made through your registration confirmation, subject to availability.

### Can I attend more than one workshop?

Yes, attendees may register for up to four workshops, provided there are no scheduling conflicts.

Doors open at 9:00 AM PT. Early arrival is recommended to allow time for check-in and breakfast prior to the keynote at 10:00 AM PT.
